Saturday, June 18 was going to be one of those lazy, second-cup-of-coffee days. It had been a busy week, but there was nothing on the calendar. However, at about 7:45am I was alerted to a call for a pediatric cardiac arrest. I responded to the hospital to find that a 4 month old had died.

I found our personnel in the consultation room. They were just hanging out; checking in on each other. Moments later we were asked to leave the room as the family had arrived and needed a place to be. As I was leaving to continue my time with our crew, the ER staff introduced me to the family. "This is the Chaplain with the Fire Department. He'll be able to help you."

I watched my crew walk away knowing I'd have the chance to connect with them again. For now, God had brought a shattered family into my life.

I walked back into the consultation room and sat with the grieving parents. They were a young couple in their early 20s. They struggled for words; struggled for answers. I sat with them offering hope when it seemed right; sitting silently when it didn't.

I know all about the responsibility of representing Jesus to the world. I understand the privilege of being His hands and feet to the broken. But what still amazes me, is that while I'm *being* Jesus, I'm also *meeting* Jesus.

That is, while I'm out representing Him, I'm also caring for Him, comforting Him, loving Him. Jesus talked about this in Matthew 25.

The King will reply, "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Matthew 25:40
